Common Sense Rules

- **ALWAYS WALK** in hallways, courtyard
- **Put trash in proper containers**
- No jumping off/ between the amphitheater
- Use appropriate language (includes name calling, the F-bomb)
- Do not spit, eat sunflower seeds or chew gum
- Be responsible for personal belongings, and don't touch other people's stuff
- Do not ride skateboards, rollerblades, or scooters on campus



Other information to know:

- Once you arrive on campus, you must stay on campus. No locker access until 7:45 am.
- Selling anything at school is not allowed (candy, cards, other fundraisers)
- Only bring money for lunch/snacks.
- Keep all valuables at home.
- Keep your locker combination to self
- No plagiarism or cheating

Lunch Time

- Noon aides, security and custodial personnel directions **NEED** to be followed at all times
- No backpacks out lunch/ cafeteria
- Eat at the lunch benches
- Put your trash and other's trash in trash cans. Do your part and recycle.
- Do not touch other people's food w/o permission
- Do not take food or drink outside of the bench area (will get trash pick up)

Dress Code



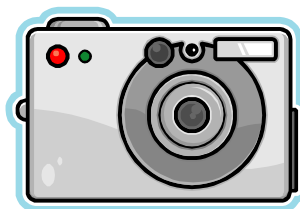
- All tank tops must have at least a 1 inch shoulder strap (shirts must completely cover waist area) Undergarments must be concealed
- Pants must be worn above the hip bone (No sagging belts must be worn)
- Hats/ head-wear – except J. H. Hull or THS hats
- No flip-flops. Athletic shoes are required for PE



Electronics Policy



- Phones are allowed at school, can **NOT be heard or seen while on campus.**
- We recommend you keep phone in locker.
 - 1st time: Pick up in office after school
 - 2nd time: Parent needs to pick up in office + detention
 - 3rd time: Confiscated and Sat. School
 - 4th time: You will need to check in / out phone
- I-pods, PSP players, cameras, other electronic games, etc. are not allowed at school unless teacher/school planned.



= No! No!

Other objects not allowed at school

- Laser pointers – are dangerous. Use will result in suspension from school.
- Personal items of value to you – *if they are stolen, the school is not responsible*
- No permanent markers or sharpies
- No glass bottles
- No Aerosol Spray cans
- No lighters, pocket knives, imitation knife combs
- No dangerous objects



Absences

- It is mandatory by law that you attend school on a daily basis.
- If absent, you need to put your absent note in the box in the office when you return. **ABSENT NOTES ARE MANDATORY!**
- Excessive unexcused absences = **SARB**

Unexcused Tardies



Be on Time, Ready to Learn...

- 3 unexcused tardies in one period = 45 minute After School Detention
- 4 unexcused tardies in one period = N on report card
- 5 unexcused tardies in one period = U on report card
- 8th tardy in one period = Saturday School

What if...



- I get headaches, can I bring aspirin (inhaler) to school?
- I have a doctor's appointment, can I leave early?
- My friend comes to visit, can I bring him to school?
- I lose something I brought to school?
- I lose the book that was issued to me?

Zero Tolerance

- **The following violations will result in immediate suspension and recommendation to expel:**
- Causing serious injury to others
- Assault or battery upon a school employee
- Possession of a firearm (including imitations)
- Brandishing a knife- no matter the size
- Sale of a controlled substance (drugs)
- Committing or attempting to commit a sexual assault or battery
- Possession of an explosive
- Robbery or extortion



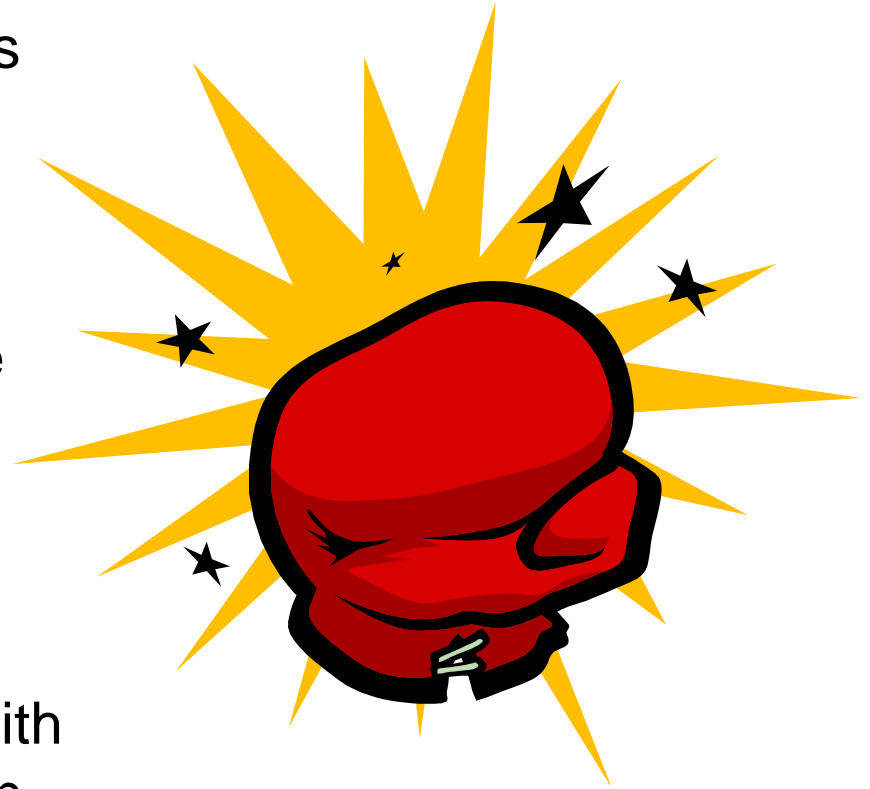
If you know that someone has a dangerous object or something they shouldn't at school, what should you do?

- Tell an adult on campus (principal, assistant principal, teacher, noon assistant, staff member)
- This includes overhearing someone saying something that threatens the safety of others or themselves.
- Be sure to pay close attention to who is saying what and who it is about.
- Always remember: "This is YOUR school"

DANGER!

Why do I get suspended for fighting when I didn't even throw a punch?

- A fight has two participants
- You may not taunt or provoke someone into fighting
- Even observers or people encouraging/ videoing the fight can be suspended
- J.H. Hull provides alternatives to resolving disagreements: Talking with counselor or administration

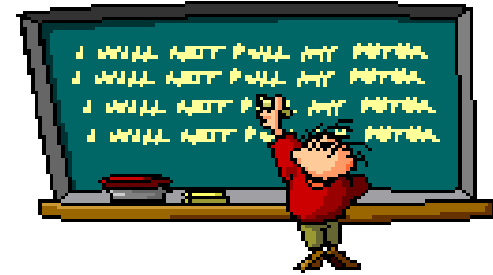




Possible consequences:

- Teacher Detention (recess, lunch or afterschool)
- School Detention: Campus clean up and afterschool.
- Saturday School
- In-house suspension
- Suspension
- Police citation
- Restitution
- Adjustment Transfer to another middle school
- Expulsion (out of TUSD)

- In office on computer and in student file
- Everything is recorded
- Sent to high school Dean's office when you leave

School Resource Officer

- Daytime Loitering
- Cigarettes/drugs
- Sexual Harassment
- Graffiti – tagging, carving.
- Skateboarding/helmets
- Threats
- No loitering afterschool in front of school
- Behaviors to/ from school

GOAL: EARN HULL POINTS

 - 1) Academics

1) Academics:

- x5 points = Every A, B, C, D Grade
- Possible: 5 pts x 6 classes = **30 Pts**

2) Effort:

- Each class (x6 classes) = 1-5
- “Average” must be **18+ pts** **10 Pts**

3)Citizenship:

- Each class (x6 classes) = U, N, S, E
- Each **S**atisfactory & **E**xcellent = 5 pts
- 5pts x 6 classes = **30 Pts**
